MANAGEMENT REPORT OF FUND PERFORMANCE

Financial Highlights

This Management Report of Fund Performance represents the portfolio management team's view of the significant factors and developments affecting the Fund's performance and outlook for the six month period ended June 30, 2022. Every effort has been made to ensure the information contained in this Management Report of Fund Performance is accurate and complete, however, the Fund cannot guarantee the accuracy or the completeness of this material. For more information, please refer to the Fund's prospectus ("Prospectus"). In this report, "Manager", refers to 3iQ Corp., the manager of the Fund. The "Fund" refers to 3iQ CoinShares Bitcoin ETF. In addition, "net asset value" or "NAV" refers to the value of the Fund as calculated for transaction purposes, on which the discussion of Fund performance is based.

Investment Objective and Strategies

The investment objectives of the Fund are to seek to provide unitholders of the Fund with exposure to the digital asset bitcoin and the daily price movements of the United States dollar price of bitcoin, and the opportunity for long-term capital appreciation. To achieve its investment objectives, the Fund invests in long-term holdings of bitcoin, purchased from reputable bitcoin trading platforms and OTC counterparties, in order to provide investors with a convenient, safer alternative to a direct investment in bitcoin. The Fund does not speculate with regard to short-term changes in bitcoin prices.

Risk

The risks associated with investing in the Fund remain as discussed in the Prospectus. The Fund is suitable for investors looking for long-term capital appreciation of bitcoin and those who have the capacity to absorb a loss on their investment. The NAV of the units will vary according to the value of bitcoin included in the Fund's portfolio. The value of the bitcoin will be influenced by factors which are not within the control of the Fund or the Manager. The Fund was created to invest in bitcoin and is not expected to have exposure to any other investments or assets. Other than cash or cash equivalents, the Fund will invest substantially all of its assets in bitcoin. The NAV per unit may be more volatile than the value of a more broadly diversified portfolio and may fluctuate substantially over short periods of time. This may have a negative impact on the NAV of the units.

For the six month period ended June 30, 2022, there were no changes affecting the overall level of risk associated with an investment in the Fund. Therefore, the overall level of Fund risk and investor risk tolerance remains as stated in the Prospectus.

Results of Operations

During the six month period ended June 30, 2022, units of the Fund returned (59.1)%.

The net asset value of the Fund was \$239.0 million as at June 30, 2022. Changes since January 1, 2022 were composed primarily of net redemptions of units of \$148.5 million and net loss from operations of \$541.7 million for the six month period ended June 30, 2022.

The investment performance of the Fund includes income and expenses which vary year over year.

Market and Fund Performance Review

MVIS CryptoCompare Bitcoin Benchmark Rate Index maintained by MV Index Solutions GmbH ("MVIS") and Bloomberg are used to source the data with returns calculated net of fees by the Manager.

During the six month ended period June 30, 2022, bitcoin moved from \$45,972 to \$18,923, a return of (58.8)%. The Fund's NAV performance over the same period was (59.1)%. The Fund's market price return performance was (59.2)%.

The first half of 2022 has been a volatile year for risky assets and bitcoin has been no exception. After reaching a new all-time high in November of 2021, bitcoin price ended 2021 at \$45,972 and was \$18,923 at June 30, 2022, or (58.8)%. During the same time period, the Fund's NAV dropped from \$7.69 to \$3.15, or (59.1)%.

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Inflation, which has been inching up steadily since Q3 of 2021, has continued to climb in 2022. June year-over-year inflation in the US was 8.6%, marking the highest level of inflation since December of 1981. To combat inflation, the Federal Reserve promptly proceeded to hike interest rates. In March 2022, the Federal Reserve hiked interest rates by 25bps for the first time since 2018, which was followed by a 50bp increase in May and further 75bps in June. It remains to be seen whether these interest rate hikes will be effective in curbing inflation.

Bitcoin's correlation with the S&P500, which historically has been low, started to increase since Q3 of 2021, as investors view both as risky assets/index markets that are sensitive to volatility in market sentiment and interest rates.

For the six month period ended June 30, 2022, the Fund has completed the following:

- On April 18, 2022, The Bitcoin Fund announced that unitholders would have the voluntary option to convert all or part of their units into units of the Fund as an additional option in connection with The Bitcoin Fund's annual redemption.
- On May 31, 2022, 3,591,213 units of The Bitcoin Fund (the "Conversion Units") were surrendered for conversion to units of the Fund. The Conversion Units were converted to 23,462,037 units of the Fund on June 1, 2022, valued at \$123,642,589.

From time to time, both a discount and premium to NAV have been observed for the Fund in the period ended June 30, 2022. The lowest discount was -3.67%. The largest premium observed was 4.17%. This is a function of investors buying and selling a limited number of units on the Toronto Stock Exchange.

Related Party Transactions

Expenses absorbed by the Manager:

In its discretion, the Manager may pay certain expenses of the Fund out of its own monies but any such payments shall not oblige the Manager to make similar payments in the future, and the Manager's payment of such expenses may be discontinued at any time, without notice to unitholders.

During the six months ended June 30, 2022, the Manager absorbed \$543,208 of the Fund's expenses.

Management fees:

The Manager is responsible for managing and directing the undertaking, operations and affairs of the Fund, including managing and directing the investments. The Fund pays an annual management fee to the Manager amounting to 1% of the Fund's net asset value calculated daily and payable monthly, plus applicable taxes, in respect of each of the units of the Fund.

During the six months ended June 30, 2022, \$4,170,725 in management fees were charged by the Manager. These transactions occurred in the normal course of operations and the fees are measured at exchange value, which is the amount established and agreed to by the related parties.

CoinShares agreement:

On March 31, 2021, the Fund entered into an investment agreement with CoinShares Capital Markets (Jersey) Limited ("CoinShares"). The Manager agreed to rebate CoinShares' proportionate share of management fees and expenses incurred by the Fund in exchange for CoinShares' investment in the Fund.

Once the NAV of the Fund exceeds \$2 billion (the "Threshold Amount"), the Manager shall pay to CoinShares an amount equal to 25% of the annual management fee due on any assets under management in excess of the Threshold Amount.

For the six months ended June 30, 2022, the Manager paid CoinShares \$4,017,999.

As at June 30, 2022, CoinShares owns 56,623,841 units of the Fund valued at \$178,365,099.

- (2) Net assets and distributions are based on the actual number of units outstanding at the relevant time. The increase from operations is based on the weighted average number of units outstanding over the financial period.
- (3) This information is provided as at June 30, 2022 and December 31, 2021.
- (4) Management expense ratio is based on total expenses (excluding distributions, commissions, and other portfolio transaction costs) for the stated period and is expressed as an annualized percentage of daily average NAV during the period.
- (5) The trading expense ratio represents total commissions and other portfolio transaction costs expressed as an annualized percentage of daily average NAV during the period.
- (6) The Fund's portfolio turnover rate indicates how actively the Fund's portfolio manager manages its portfolio investments. A portfolio turnover rate of 100% is equivalent to the Fund buying and selling all of the securities in its portfolio once in the course of the period. The higher a fund's portfolio turnover rate in the period, the greater the trading costs payable by the Fund in the period, and the greater the chance of an investor receiving taxable capital gains in the period. 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
Financial Highlights – June 30, 2022
